The many Regency and Victorian buildings give Sidmouth its unique character, whilst award winning floral displays, the Connaught Gardens and the esplanade allow you to relax without a care in the world. Sidmouth offers a choice of pebble and family friendly sandy beaches at Clifton beach or Jacob's Ladder. Fine shops, bars and restaurants make Sidmouth a most enjoyable shopping experience, with something for everyone.

The Sidmouth Hopper gives you access to some of the most spectacular sections of England's first natural World Heritage Site – the Jurassic Coast.

Salcombe Hill, National Trust
Level easy-access paths allow you to enjoy the world class views of our coast and across the Sid Valley. For the more active a 45 minute circular route takes you along the South West Coast Path to the Frogmore Stone, above Salcombe Regis valley, before returning inland and back through woodland to the Sidmouth Hopper bus stop. Alternatively walk back down the Coast Path enjoying fine views of Sidmouth.

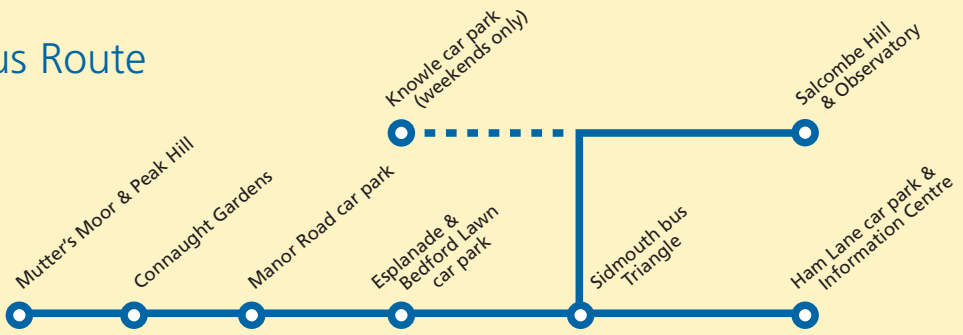
Norman Lockyer Observatory

This observatory is the UK's birthplace of astrophysics! Now run by dedicated and enthusiastic volunteers, the working optical observatory is also open to the public at certain times. Pick up a leaflet from the Sidmouth Information Centre.

Mutter's Moor, Clinton Devon Estates

Level paths and tracks allow you to explore this heathland haven - walk

in the footsteps of the infamous local smuggler – Mutter. The heathland's purple haze is best enjoyed in July and August when the heather is in flower. Great for wildlife, such as shy Dartford Warblers and chirring nightjars at dusk.

Peak Hill, National Trust

A choice of routes opposite Mutter's Moor car park take you either straight out to the South West Coast Path or through the National Trust Peak Hill woodland. You will be rewarded with fabulous views of the Triassic cliffs and the remains of the Iron Age encampment on High Peak. A steep descent along the Coast Path brings you back to Connaught Gardens.

Connaught Gardens

This Green Flag award winning garden, provided by the East Devon District Council offers live music, delightful floral displays, and a restaurant/tea rooms - making this a perfect place to unwind. Sidmouth is a National finalist in the 2007 Britain in Bloom competition, representing the South West in the Seaside Town category.

Sidmouth Information Centre

Located by the swimming pool close to the Ham Lane car park, the helpful staff can assist with accommodation, travel, advance booking for events and many other queries. There are maps, walking leaflets, books and details of many visitor attractions here.
