The Dorset and East Devon Coast World Heritage Site, also known as the **Jurassic Coast**, was made a World Heritage Site (WHS) by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) in 2001. To ensure good stewardship, all World Heritage Sites must have clear, useful and up-to-date Management Plans. The Plan for the Dorset and East Devon Coast was last revised in 2003, so the draft presented here is a significant update, and will cover the period 2009-2014.

Such a Plan enables the partnership that is responsible for the management of the Site to have clear policies on threats that might affect it, and to set out the activities it wants to undertake to benefit the people of Dorset, Devon and the UK.

The most important people for the future protection, conservation and use of the WHS are those who live or work on, or near it, and those who visit and enjoy it. This document is in draft form in order that anyone with an interest in the Site, locally or globally, can have a say in its management.
